



Super Sprint – Morgan Park Saturday 30th August 2008 Supplementary Regulations CAMS Permit No.

The event will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of CAMS, Speed Event Standing Regulations and any further supplementary regulations. Additional instructions may be issued subject to NCR 69. This event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au Insurance will be provided in accordance with Appendix 1 of the current CAMS Manual.

- 1 The Promoter of the event is the Porsche Club Queensland Inc. and the address for all correspondence is **PO Box 3133, Loganholme Qld 4129**. The Organising Committee is as follows: Bill Black 0411 195 808 Jason Arnold 0411 659 652 Phil Holzberger 0419 407 718
- 2 The event is to be held on Saturday 30th August 2008 commencing at 9:00am at Morgan Park, Warwick. Details of the circuit are as follows:
Length: 2km (or any of the short length circuits) Width: 8-10m Surface: Hot Mix Direction: Clockwise
- 3 The event will be a club supersprint (multiple car speed event), with passenger rides, demonstration drives, driver training and / or practice at the discretion of the Clerk of Course. Only financial members of the Porsche Club Queensland Inc. may enter.
- 4 The officials of the event will be as follows: Clerk of Course: Mark Stockwell Chief Steward: Peter Robinson
Compliance Checker: Leisa Stockwell Chief Scrutineer: Cyril Brown Event Secretary: Bill Black
- 5 Entries:
 - i Entries will open on Monday 4th August 2008 and **close on Wednesday 27th August 2008**.
 - ii Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate entry fee, together with a completed and signed entry form, cheques made payable to the Porsche Club Queensland Inc. and marked as "Not Negotiable".
 - iii The entry fee is **\$140 (GST Inc.)** if paid by the closing date or **\$170 if paid after the closing date**. No refund will necessarily be made for cancellation on the day of the event.
 - iv The Promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason, subject to NCR 83.
 - v The limit on the number of cars will be 98. If the event is over-subscribed, preference will be given to single vehicle entries, then Porsche vehicles, then fully completed and paid entries by receipt. The balance of entries will be returned with a full refund. The Organisers reserve the right to accept any over-subscriptions.
 - vi If more than one driver wishes to compete in the same vehicle, each driver will complete a separate entry, clearly showing that it forms part of a multiple entry.
 - vii There will be no relief drivers.
 - viii There will be a maximum of three entries per vehicle

- 6 Scrutineering will be held at the venue on the day of the event from 7:30am to 8:30am. This period may be extended at the discretion of the Event Co-ordinator. Driver briefing will be at 8:30am.
- 7 Particular attention is drawn to the rules concerning CAMS Licences which must be produced at scrutineering.
- 8 The Promoter reserves the right to abandon, or postpone, the event should the track be rendered unsuitable or less than 20 entries are received, subject to NCR 59.
- 9 Entries will be accepted in the following categories:
Open wheel race cars will have to be approved by the Organising Committee before being accepted.
Porsche cars will be classed by the 2008 Rules Classes which include: Open Class (O), MNA, MT,A, B, C, D, E and F.
Non Porsche cars are classified under NA and only compete for personal times.
- 10 Safety Requirements:
 - i All competing cars must conform with basic safety requirements as set out in CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
 - ii Exemptions apply to catch tailshaft straps, wired drain plugs, scatter shields and roll bars in accordance with CAMS relaxation of these rules to road registered cars.
 - iii Cars will not be permitted to compete unless passed in scrutineering.
 - iv Drivers must wear while competing, and present for scrutineering, the following items:
 - a Helmet approved to AS1698.
 - b Non-synthetic ankle to wrist to neck clothing.
 - c Suitable closed footwear. Note that thongs, sandals and high-heels are not acceptable.
 - v All cars must comply with the following requirements:
 - a Seat belts approved to ASE35.
 - b Securely fitted fire extinguisher approved to AS1846 or AS1848.
 - c Double throttle springs (standard on Porsche road cars).
 - d Competition number on the top left side of the windscreen in clearly visible white or yellow numbers, readily available from motorcycle shops.
 - e Blue triangle indicating the location of the battery.
 - f **All forward facing glass except windscreen to be covered completely with transparent film.** (So bring the clear "contact" and use it. Tape is not good enough.)
 - g Positive battery terminal covered or taped.
 - h Two independent fastening systems of limited extensibility on rear hinged bonnets. Note that this means of securing the bonnet is at least one additional fastening system in addition to the normal locking mechanism and safety catch.
- 12 The Event:
 - i There will be a compulsory driver's briefing at 08:30am.
 - ii A practice session may be held after the drivers' briefing prior to the commencement of the event proper. Further practice sessions may be held throughout the course of the event at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
 - iii The cars will be timed by AIM lap timers. It is each drivers responsibility to have a working lap timer.
 - iv The order of running will be published on the day of the event.
 - v A run will consist of a full lap warm-up, five – five timed flying laps and a half lap warm-down.
 - vi The time for each car's flying laps will be recorded per lap where ever possible.
 - vii Results will be determined by each car's lowest lap time. Points will be awarded to Porsche Club members driving Porsche vehicles in the Club Championship. No prizes will be awarded on the day.
 - viii Drivers must obey all flag signals and instructions by officials while on the circuit.
 - ix The finishing order may differ from the starting order.
- 13 It is a condition of entry that competitors agree to pay all costs incurred for the use of fire fighting equipment of their cars.
- 14 Competitors' attention is drawn to CAMS rules governing protests, namely NCR part 12.
- 15 It is an offence for any competitors to use, or attempt to use, any portion of the venue for purposes other than those that are approved.
- 16 Dangerous and/or unsuitable cars and/or drivers and/or poorly presented cars may be excluded by the Organisers at their discretion.
- 17 During the event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCA145A of the current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to Articles of Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews & officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event. This regulation serves as the required 24 hour notice to competitors, crew & officials.
- 18 Pit entry is limited to individuals 16 and over. No naked flames in the pit area.
- 19 **A Compulsory Third Party Insurance extension is required for QLD road registered vehicles.**
